



Personal Statement Example

My career goal is to assist a non-profit organisation to expand its services and reach globally. I want to help NPOs to achieve a suitable balance between the competing goals of maintaining solvency (with sufficient funds for activities) and social efficacy. I believe that working for a management consulting agency specializing in non-governmental organisations will allow me to attain my goal.


